
Question:

What does the **Do not execute SQL scripts now** check box in the Configuration Wizard do?

Net Report Answer

Automatically or Manually Executing SQL Scripts

Please note the **Do not execute SQL scripts now (only generate)** check box at the base of the **Database Configuration** dialog box in the Net Report Configuration Wizard.



Selecting The Check Box

This check box automatically generates the SQL scripts in a specific directory once the Net Report Configuration Wizard has completed. The SQL Script generation feature is intended for Database Administrators (DBAs) wishing to modify certain parameters before creating the various objects in the database. This enables DBAs to view, modify and manually execute SQL scripts later.

The SQL Scripts generated by the Net Report Configuration Wizard are in the following directory:



C:\Program Files\NetReport\database sql scripts\Oracle\YYYYMMDD-hh-mm

Please note that the SQL scripts are in a format compatible with:

- SQLPLUS worksheet (8.1i.7) for ORACLE databases
- Query Analyser for SQL Server databases

Leaving the Check Box Clear

By default the **Do not execute SQL scripts now (only generate)** check box is left clear. If the check box is clear then the SQL scripts will be automatically executed once the Net Report Configuration Wizard has completed and you will not need to manually execute them later.
