**How to Configure DataSetReport Database SQL Server rights**

**Date:** December 14th, 2009

**Problem:** SQL Server Tables or Column Description are not visible using a Connect Data Source from a remote client workstation to a Server machine.

**Case1:** the Connect Data Source on the local client workstation is pointing to an SQL Server database on the Server machine, and this SQL Server database is **not secured** in Click&DECiDE Administration Manager.

**Problem1:** you select the DataSetReport Database and the demo folder but no tables appears

**Case2:** the Connect Data Source on the local client workstation is pointing to an SQL Server database on the Server machine, and this SQL Server database is **secured** in Click&DECiDE Administration Manager.

**Problem2:** you select the DataSetReport Database and the demo folder, tables appears but column descriptions do not appear

**Solution:** the DataSetReport has been installed without rights access to everyone and you should modify the rights as follow:

Open the Microsoft SQL Management Studio Express

Select the DataSetReport database

Click **New Query**

Then depending on the authorization you want to apply:

- **Give the right on the DataSetReport database to everybody, enter:**  
`use [DataSetReport]`  
`GO`  
`GRANT SELECT TO [public]`  
`GO`  
then click **Run**
- **Give the right on the DataSetReport database and demo folder only to everybody, enter:**  
`use [DataSetReport]`  
`GO`  
`GRANT SELECT ON SCHEMA::[demo] TO [public]`  
`GO`  
then click **Run**
- **Give the right on the DataSetReport database and demo folder only to one User, enter:**  
`use [DataSetReport]`  
`GO`  
`GRANT SELECT ON SCHEMA::[demo] TO [UserName]`  
`GO`  
then click **Run**
