Port Numbers used by Click&DECiDE Programs

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Problem:

I use a Firewall and I get some problem with connection to iSeries or connection to Administration Manager using a Click&DECiDE Connect Data Source.

Explanation:

Some ports numbers have to be opened for some modules of Click&DECiDE programs.

Solution:

Open your Firewall Settings and add the following port numbers:

Steps

1. If your connection concerns a client computer and a direct access to the iSeries (using iSeries TCP/IP data source), the port number **7726** has to be open.
2. If your connection concerns a client computer and a the Server Machine where Click&DECiDE Administration Manager has been installed, and you are using a Click&DECiDE Connect Data Source, the port number **7725** has to be open.
3. If your connection concerns a client computer and a the Server Machine where Click&DECiDE Administration Manager has been installed, and you are using a Click&DECiDE iSeries TCP/IP data source, the port number **7726** has to be open.
