How to validate the Click&DECiDE Code Signature?

Problem:

Sometimes Windows 2008 does not contain the certificates allowing to validate our code signature.

Explanation:

The signature for SETUP.EXE and Data1.cab must be validated.

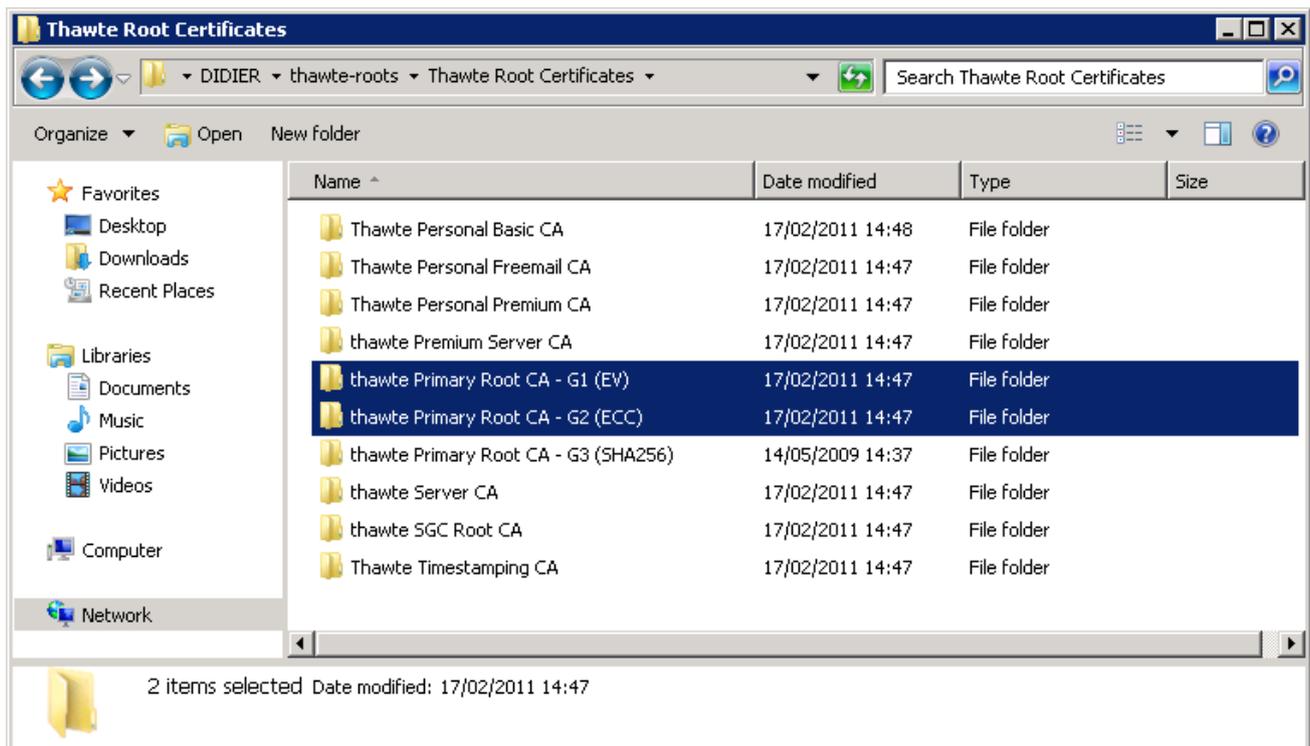
Solution:

The following certificates must be installed as Trusted Root Authority in the local computer store.

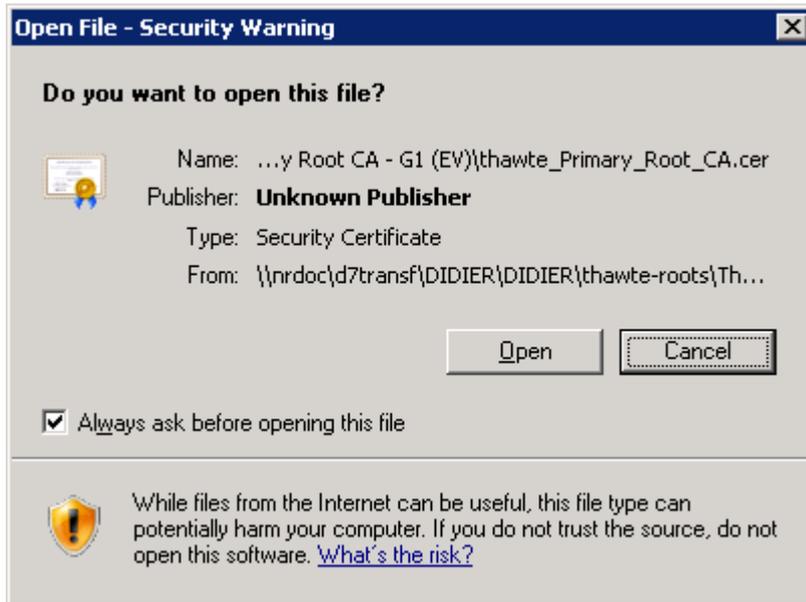
- Thawte Primary Root CA – G1 (EV)
- Thawte Primary Root CA – G2 (ECC)

Steps

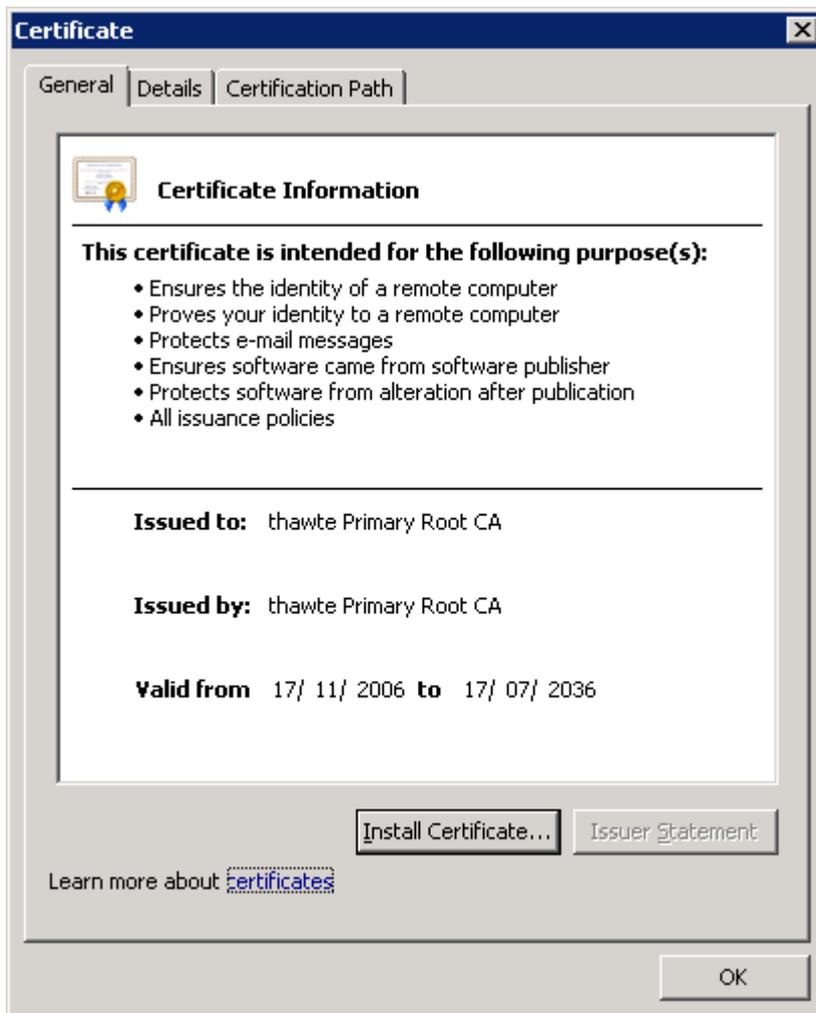
1. Download the certificates files at: <http://www.clickndecide.com/downloads/kits/thawte-roots.zip>
2. Unzip the zip file in a temporary directory. The content is the following:



3. Go first to the "thawte Primary Root CA - G1 (EV)" directory.
4. Double-click on the "thawte_Primary_Root_CA.cer" file.



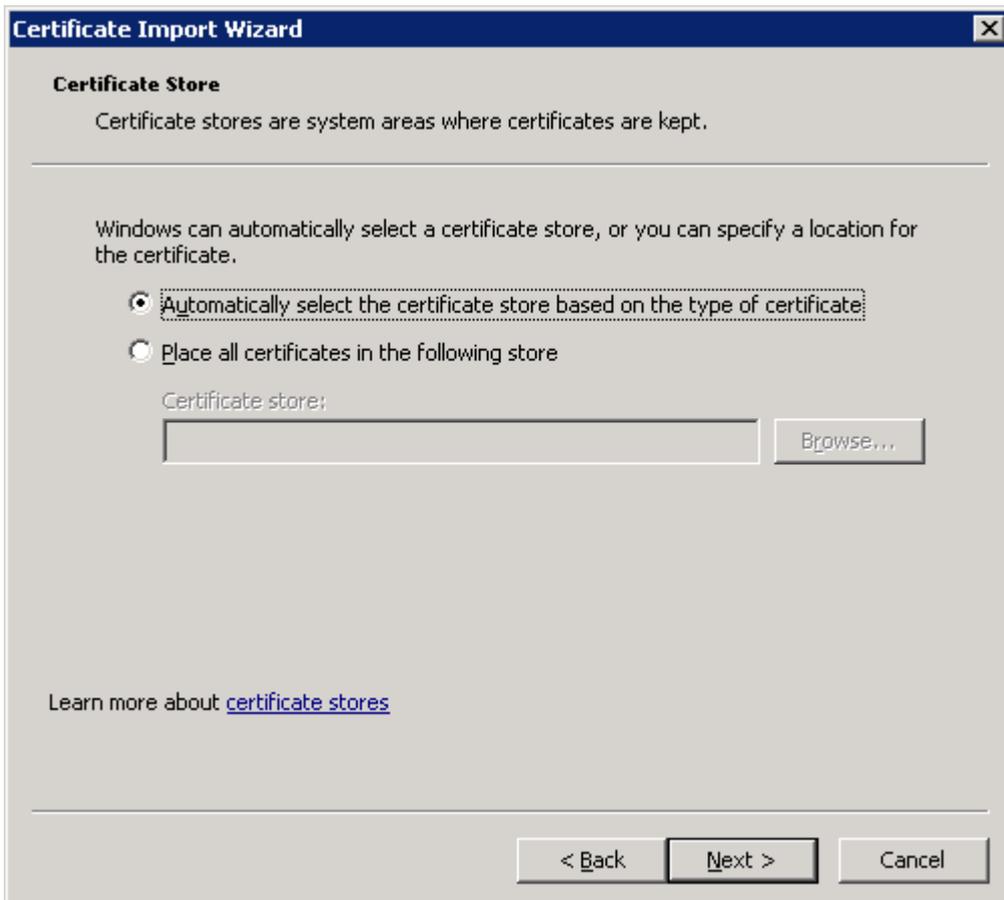
5. Click **Open**



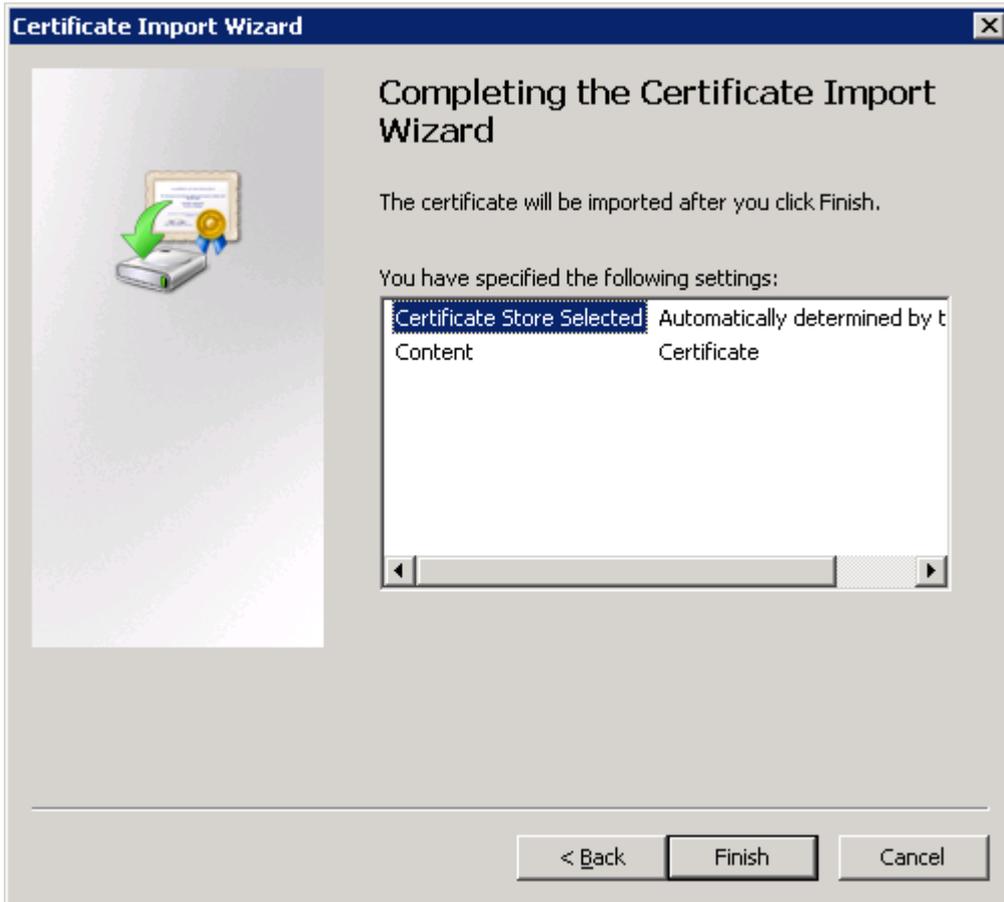
6. Click **Install Certificate**



7. Click **Next**



8. Keep the first Automatic option checked and click **Next**



9. Click **Finish**



10. Go now to the “**thawte Primary Root CA - G2 (ECC)**” directory.

11. Repeat the above steps 3 to 9 for the “**thawte Primary Root CA - G2_ECC.cer**” file.
