



## Knowledge Base Article: Article 242 How to connect to a SQL Server 2012?

Date: March 22nd, 2013

### **Problem:**

Once you have installed Microsoft SQL Server 2012, you can have trouble to connect to any database from Click&DEDCiDE products (NSI and/or BAI).

#### **Explanation:**

By default, when you install Microsoft SQL Server 2012, the Server roles used to grant server-wide security to the NT-AUTHORITY\SYSTEM login are not sufficient. By default they look like:



#### Solution:

Start Microsoft SQL Server Management Studio. Select the Security> Login Branch and double-click theNT-AUTHORITY\SYSTEM login. On the Login Properties dialog box, select the Server Roles level and check on thesysadminrole,thenclickOK.
